Dam safety upgrade costs / Inspector General Emergency Management (IGEM) review costs

• Stakeholders questioned the costs associated with dam safety inspections and IGEM systems

SunWater's proposed costs

- Stakeholders considered that the QCA should compare SunWater's maintenance and operational costs against other entities, especially non-government entities. In the past SunWater's costs were only compared against other government owned entities.
- Stakeholders noted that the local management arrangements (LMA) process identified inefficiencies that should be applied to the bulk scheme.
- Stakeholders questioned whether some expenditure should be in opex rather than non-routine expenditure.
- Stakeholders questioned whether some of the corrective and preventative maintenance for the scheme's dam should be categorised as dam safety improvements rather than non-routine expenditure.
- Stakeholders questioned the non-routine expenditure project scheduled in 2053.

Other issues

• Stakeholders questioned the QCA's approach to pricing high priority distribution losses.
