Aurizon Network's FY2017 Revenue Cap Submission Revision

5 December 2017

Dear Stephen

On 26 September 2017 Aurizon Network submitted to the Queensland Competition Authority (QCA) its FY2017 Revenue Adjustment Amounts Submission (FY2017 Revenue Cap Submission) a net recovery of \$40.5 million being sought from Access Holders.

The Revenue Adjustment Amounts included \$1.3 million of costs associated with Aurizon Network's Ground Penetrating Radar (GPR) works in accordance with clause 4.3(c)(v) of Aurizon Network's 2016 Access Undertaking.

We are now amending our FY2017 Revenue Cap Submission to remove those costs from the FY2017 claim, however we reserve our rights to include these costs within a future regulatory cost recovery process.

We attach a revised FY2017 Revenue Cap Submission (clean and mark up). We note that the only change to this submission, relative to the original, is removal of the GPR costs. This results in a proposed net recovery of \$39.1 million.
